***Having said that, if there are extenuating circumstances, parents or students may call Marcie Martinez at 830-643-5729, as the driving instructors may be able to work with a special schedule/situation.

***A Texas Department of Public Safety Driver Education Certificate of Completion Form (also called a DE-964) will be awarded once a student has met all course requirements with a passing grade of 70 or higher. **If a student does not pick up the Driver Education Certificate from a driving instructor at the end of the course, the certificate will be safely held at the NBISD Administration Center with Marcie Martinez (830-643-5729).** Due to Covid-19, It is required to schedule an appointment with Marcie Martinez to pick up the Driver Education certificate. Please call two weeks in advance of a student's driving exam with DPS for an appointment. **The TX DPS office will NOT allow a student to take a driving exam without the certificate (DE-964).**

NBISD DRIVER EDUCATION COURSE – SUMMER 2021 COURSE DETAILS, RESPONSIBILITIES AND SIGNATURE

Contract Length: Students have seven (7) months (from first day of classroom instruction) to complete the NBISD Driver Education Course.

Completion of this course is:

DRIVER EDUCATION TEEN & INSTRUCTOR RESPONSIBILITY:

- Thirty-two (32) hours In-class Instruction with passing grade of at least 70
- Behind-the-wheel and classroom Instruction time with NBISD Instructor
- Seven (7) hours of actual driving/seven (7) hours in-car observation

PARENT/LEGAL GUARDIAN AND TEEN RESPONSIBILITY:

- Thirty (30) hours documented in car training with PARENT/ADULT OVER 21 with valid license (documented on 30-hour Behind-the-Wheel Instruction Log)
- Twenty (20) hours day time driving + Ten (10) hours night driving (sunset to sunrise)

DRIVER EDUCATION TEEN RESPONSIBILITY: (DO NOT WATCH THIS VIDEO UNTIL INSTRUCTOR TELLS YOU TO DO SO.)

- View Impact Texas Teen Drivers (ITTD) 2 hour free video (<https://impacttexasteendrivers.dpsTexas.gov/>). Upon completion, a Certificate of Completion is issued and must be presented prior to administering the driver skills examination. **Certificate must be dated within 90 days of the administered skills examination.**

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR PARENTS & TEENS:

- This course is designed to teach students how to drive safely and does not guarantee a driver license.
- Attendance: State law requires that students attend all 32 hours of the classroom portion. Missed time must be made up and completed during another session. (These sessions are to be scheduled with Instructors). A student automatically falls after 10 missed hours and will be required to retake the entire classroom portion.
- **If the student falls the classroom portion, their permit certificate will be voided through DPS.** Students must submit a new registration in order to start a new class. The student must attend and complete assignments for the first (3) days of classroom (the first module - 8 hours) to receive a Beginner Permit. Late arrivals and leaving early will count as a one-hour absence, if over 10 minutes late. If this course is not completed within this time frame there is a re-enrollment fee of \$125.00.
- **I wish to enroll my child in the NBISD Driver Education Course.** I have read and understand the course contract and information provided. I also realize that if my child fails to complete the course, a refund will not be given for the course fee.
- **Payment in full of \$375.00 is required by June 1 2021 for class attendance. No exceptions.**
