2) Wellness and Sexual Health Curriculum (WSH) during COVID-19 closure

- a) If we return by May, we will proceed with the WSH curriculum as planned.
- b) If we do not return, it is suggested we postpone all Wellness and Sexual Health Curriculum for the rest of this 2019-2020 school year. This will include maturation presentations for 4th and 5th grade students.
 - i) Sensitivity of subject matter
 - ii) Difficulty with sharing lessons virtually, ie siblings, others at home.
 - iii) Copyright issues: Current program is powerpoint based, not web based. The current curriculum is being revised and plans to be available 2020-2021 school year.
 - iv) Unable to have experts present legal issues, physiology, sexually transmitted illness.
 - v) EHAA legal/local
- c) Thoughts and Discussion
Discussed possibly sending information out to parents to go over with their children. Look at other options or curriculum to be offered to parents. Dr Briggs stated that the curriculum is taught by experts, ie Doctors, science teachers, nurses, and other professionals and whoever provides this sensitive material would need to be comfortable sharing it. Clay Gillentine shared that SHAC is just recommending to the board to postpone the Wellness and Sexual Health Curriculum until next year if we don't return this school year.

27 Yes votes to postpone the sexual health and wellness curriculum for the 2019-2020 school year. There was one No vote.

3) Child Nutrition Department updates - Catherine Vanderbrook/Ashley West

Providing approximately 1,000 meals/day as of March 17 (includes breakfast and lunch)

Mobile meals to target areas. As of March 24th they are utilizing 6 busses going to 7 stops.

Home deliveries are being taken to certain families in need.

Transportation and SRO's are helping with meals. Starting April 13th, Veramendi and Voss farms will only serve meals one time/day for safety and health protection for staff. Lone Star will stay at twice/day. Food Service is remaining compliant with the Department of Agriculture. They are implementing several food and safety procedures, ie. employees wash hands every 15 minutes, sanitizing equipment every hour, taped areas for social distancing, and all employees wearing face masks as of April 7th.

- a) MANY Thanks to all NBISD staff! Working super hard to provide breakfast and lunch to thousands of students.

Catherine Vanderbrook stated that their staff's attitudes were phenomenal! Senator Donna Campbell even stopped by for a visit.

Ashley West is asking for help promoting information out weekly to the community via radio, PTA, or newspaper. They are looking at applying for a grant.

Employee Appreciation for food service workers! They are still working Monday- Friday.
