The Law

The most recent law that affects Title 1 is the Every Student Succeeds Act. The law requires:

- ❖ That school districts have a written policy regarding parent and family engagement, which can be accessed on the school website
- ❖ That parents be involved in the design, operation, and evaluation of Title 1;
- ❖ That parents be consulted about home/school activities and be trained to help their children;
- ❖ That whenever possible, activities should be presented in the language spoken by the majority of the Title 1 parents.

Parent Notification

- The teacher's college major, whether he/she has any advanced degrees, and the field of discipline of the certification or degree
