





New Braunfels ISD Student Process Map for COVID -19



Close contact is defined as either of the following at any time in the last 14 days when the infected individual was infectious:

- Being directly exposed to fluids from the mouth or nose (e.g., being coughed on); or
- Being within 6 feet for a largely uninterrupted period of time throughout the course of a day totaling approximately 15 minutes.

- **High-Risk Symptoms:**
1. fever temperature greater than or equal to 100.0 degrees Fahrenheit
 2. cough (with new onset or worsening cough in the case of asthma)
 3. shortness of breath/increased work of breathing
 4. loss of sense of taste or smell
- *Low-Risk Symptoms:**
1. sore throat
 2. nasal congestion/nasal discharge
 3. nausea/vomiting/diarrhea
 4. myalgias (muscle aches) unrelated to exercise /injury
 5. headache
 6. fatigue

Students who provide proof of COVID vaccination and are 14 days past last dose are exempt from quarantine as long as they are symptom free. Those students who have tested positive for COVID-19 in the past 90 days are exempt from quarantine.
